In the framework of the project *Teaching and Learning in Special Education with Information Communication Technologies*— TELESEICT (Project Number: 2016-1-PT01-KA203-022950) — www.teleseict.eu - from 14th to 17thMay 2017, the local working group for the theme 2 — Palacky University, Olomouc, Albanian Institute for Public Affairs and University of Oradea — met in Oradea, Romania, in order to work and discuss around the theme of Visual Impairment.

The first day of the working meeting (15 May 2017) started with a visit to the Oradea University Campus, followed by a welcome meeting with the Director of the Teacher Training Department of the University of Oradea (PhD. Prof. Florica Orţan) and the Vice-Rector University of Oradea responsible for scientific research (PhD. Prof. Eugen Macocean). During the two meetings were discussed aspects related to the specificities of higher education in Romania, in the Czech Republic and in Albania, and new opportunies for international co-operation were identified between the three partner countries.

During the first working meeting of the team members of the project, the participants from each country presented and discussed the materials related to the issues of visually impaired people and the possibilities of using ICT for the recovery and social inclusion of this category of people. A series of proposals have been formulated and the preliminary schedule for the day when the three partner universities will coordinate the IP activities in Sakarya, Turkey has been concluded.







In the second day of the working meeting (16 May 2017) two institutions were visited which are Silent partner in project. First visited was «Cristal» School Center for Inclusive sensory education from Oradea where project team members have been able to see various education and recovery strategies for visually impaired students using new IT technologies.











During the second part of the working day, the project team members visited the School of Inclusive Education no. 1 Oradea, as well as the "CES" Association from Oradea, where were discussed the problems faced by students with different types of disabilities (mental deficiency, associated defects sensory impairments, etc.). In this case also, the use of ICT in the education and recovery of these pupils was discussed, a comparative analysis of the special / special inclusive education system in Romania, Czech Republic and Albania has been carried out and more possibilities for cooperation between institutions from these countries.

At the end of this two days meeting the working group prepared of the structure and the main points of the material to be used by students during the IP in Sakarya, Turcia.
